
Gerber Guardian Sheath adjustments, adjustable tension on knife retention how to reverse clip for tip up or tip down carry.


Operating instructions for the Guardian Back-Up Sheath System:

The Guardian Back-Up knife and sheath is equipped with several safety features and when used property can be an

extremely versatile knife. To make the knife easy to remove, slide the adjustment buttons on the side of the sheath toward the



ent buttons on the side of the sheath toward the closed end of the sheath (See Figure A). This adjustment can only be done when the knife is not in the sheath. Conversely, the tension required to remove the knife will be increased if the buttons are



moved toward the open end of the sheath. This setting should be used during strenuous activity to prevent loss of the knife. The Guardian Back-Up comes with a reversible boot dip which fits on the side of the sheath without a Gerber logo. This clip allows the user to carry the knife with the handle up or down depending on the knifes use. To rotate the clip, put a quarter in the clip gap (See Figure B) and twist. This will push the sides of the clip away from the plastic sheath and allow it to be removed. Then simply invert the clip and snap back into place using the same method. Another safety feature of the boot clip is the hooked end

of the actual clip. This hooked end prevents the clip from slipping off of a boot or belt by catching on a seam or edge.
